



K-5 Schedule

All classes meet on Mondays and Wednesdays. Each class hour costs \$400 for the school year. The two-hour Language Arts class is billed as two class hours. The following is a schedule of the K-5 school day:

We charge a shipping and handling fee *per class*, and include it in the total book cost listed in the course descriptions. If you would like to purchase books used or through a different source, please see the attached curriculum list for information. Your student may not begin classes without the required books. If your student comes to the first class without the necessary books, we will provide them to your student, and charge your account accordingly.

K5 Class Descriptions

Language Arts K5

Each class day will begin with devotions and prayer. This class is structured as a basic phonics reading program in which children actually read the twelve small books in the set. Also included is a phonics blend and word review book for reinforcement at home. Students learn and review vowel sounds, blends, one-and-two consonant words, words with special sounds, and sentence comprehension. The beginning of each class day will include devotions and prayer.

Books: \$98

Math K5

Covers writing numbers through 100, simple addition and subtraction, telling time, sequencing, number words and working with money.

Books: \$49

Handwriting K5

****Note:** This class will be 30 minutes long. It is combined with Art to make up one full class in the tuition fee structure.** From the publisher: "The manuscript writing book correlates with the 5-year-old kindergarten phonics program. As students learn and practice letters, blends, words, and sentences, they also learn and practice letter formation." Also included in this course is the Draw Write Now program in which students learn to draw simple pictures and write about them.

Art K5

****Note:** This class will be 30 minutes long. It is combined with Handwriting to make up one full class in the tuition fee structure.** This course is designed to enhance early learning by exploring the concepts of line, shape, color, and texture in a variety of media. Projects include but are not confined to: finger painting, crayon drawings, tempera painting, bag art, story art, and edible art. A supply list may be provided from time to time.

Fee: A \$50 materials fee is required.

Social Studies (Semester 1)/ Science (Semester 2)

The Social Studies class, taught during the first semester, will be using the Bob Jones Heritage series. The student book gives colorful narrative about early American life, while the notebook pages support the text with interesting activities. The Science class, taught during the second semester, also uses Bob Jones curriculum. From the publisher: "Introduce your (student) to the world around them with this full-color student text. Guiding children into a deeper appreciation of the Lord's handiwork, it uses the five senses to explore space, plants, matter, animals, basic laws of motion, weather and more."

Books: \$74

Busy Bodies

****Note:** This class is combined with Snack and Play to make up one full class in the tuition fee structure.** Busy Bodies is a movement and motion class for the very young. Students will be introduced to fun games and activities as they learn the value of exercise and sportsmanship. On inclement days, students will learn about proper nutrition, safety, and good manners.

Fee: A \$30 materials fee is required.

Snack and Play

****Note:** This class is combined with Busy Bodies to make up one full class in the tuition fee structure.** Snack and Play gives young students a time to wind-down from the school day, eat an afternoon snack, and enjoy some free play time.
