



2nd Grade Schedule

All classes meet on Mondays and Wednesdays. Each class hour costs \$400 for the school year. The two-hour Language Arts class is billed as two class hours. The following is a schedule of the 2nd Grade school day:

Cross Creek will have the books necessary for your student's classes available for purchase. You will be able to pick them up on Parent Night in August. We charge a shipping and handling fee per class, and include it in the total book cost listed in the course descriptions. If you would like to purchase books used or through a different source, please see the attached curriculum list for information. Your student may not begin classes without the required books. If your student comes to the first class without the necessary books, we will provide them to your student, and charge your account accordingly.

2nd Grade Class Descriptions

Language Arts 2

Each class day will begin with devotions and prayer. Language Arts 2 is a phonics-based reading curriculum providing: daily seatwork to reinforce phonics concepts; a handbook presenting six easy steps to reading with ample practice and review; and a set of nine readers that correlate with the student's progress. This course also introduces students to concepts such as: punctuation for three kinds of sentences, compound words, rhyming words, synonyms, antonyms, contractions, plurals, and possessive words. Spelling is also included in this course.

Books: \$210

Math 2

This course reviews and introduces: place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions, money, temperature, time, perimeter, story problems, estimation, graphs, rulers, and measures. Clear explanations and lots of practice make carrying and borrowing easy.

Books: \$66

Explorations in Geography and European/American Culture

In this exciting class, students are introduced to geography and European and American culture with an emphasis on our Christian history in America. The teacher will use the Bob Jones curriculum to read to the students. This will give students a chance to hear how a story should be read as well as teaching comprehension as she will be asking questions to discuss what they have just read. During class time, they will have a page to color from the reproducibles or afterwards, do a craft or activity. All school work will be accomplished in the classroom.

- Materials: a \$30 materials fee is required.

Art 2

This course is designed to enhance the subjects of reading, writing, social studies, and the humanities through visual and tactile projects that are **FUN!** Projects may include but are not confined to: drawing, painting, sculpture, edible art, and book writing. Additional supply lists may be provided from time to time.

Fee: a \$50 materials fee is required.

Handwriting 2

****Note:** This class will be 30 minutes long. It is combined with Art 1 to make up one full class in the tuition fee structure.** From the publisher: "Begins with single letters and progresses to blends, special sounds, and words." This is the A Beka 1 cursive course that we are choosing to introduce in the second grade this year. It is for the student who is just learning cursive lettering. Also included in this course is the Draw Write Now program in which students learn to draw simple pictures and write about them.

Books: \$36

Busy Bodies

****Note:** This class is combined with Snack and Play to make up one full class in the tuition fee structure.** Busy Bodies is a movement and motion class for the very young. Students will be introduced to fun games and activities as they learn the value of exercise and sportsmanship. On inclement days, students will learn about proper nutrition, safety, and good manners.

- Materials: a \$30 materials fee is required.

Snack and Play

****Note:** This class is combined with Busy Bodies to make up one full class in the tuition fee structure.** Snack and Play gives young students a time to wind-down from their school day, have an afternoon snack, and enjoy some free play time.
