



5th Grade Schedule

All classes meet on Mondays and Wednesdays. Each class hour costs \$400 for the school year. The two-hour Language Arts class is billed as two class hours. The following is a schedule of the 5th Grade school day:

Cross Creek will have the books necessary for your student's classes available for purchase. You will be able to pick them up on Parent Night in August. We charge a shipping and handling fee per class, and include it in the total book cost listed in the course descriptions. If you would like to purchase books used or through a different source, please see the attached curriculum list for information. Your student may not begin classes without the required books. If your student comes to the first class without the necessary books, we will provide them to your student, and charge your account accordingly.

5th Grade Class Descriptions

Language Arts 5/6

Each class day will begin with devotions and prayer. Language Arts 5/6 uses a classical approach to reading. This literature class for grades 3 and 4 will continue to develop reading comprehension, spelling, and vocabulary skills through classical children's literature. A study guide from Progeny Press will be used with each literature selection. Progeny Press is committed to teaching good cultural literature, examined from a Christian perspective. This class will examine literary terminology and technique to equip students for understanding the craft of writing and to enhance their joy of learning. This class will also include grammar instruction using *Easy Grammar* texts which uses the prepositional approach combined with other effective strategies that help students to understand grammar.

- Fees: a \$40 fee covers novel depreciation (\$10) and copy costs for literature guides (\$30). Novels are owned by Cross Creek.

Math 5

This Saxon math course emphasizes multiplying by four-digit numbers and dividing by three-digit numbers, fractions, measures, working with decimals, rounding off, and more. The book can be purchased with a computer CD that will walk your student through each lesson, explaining the lesson practice problems in detail, promoting greater understanding on home study days.

Living in God's Love

Zoology 1

Exploring the United States 3rd/6th

This course will introduce students to the United States. The students will do an in-depth study of geography including map skills, landforms, capitals and states. The course will also include an introduction to United States government and economics. The regions of the United States will be studied in depth, learning about the land, economy, and culture of each region.

- Fees: a \$40 fee covers the \$30 copy fee for extensive geography supplements and \$10 fee covering materials used for hands-on activities

Zoology 3

From the publisher: "The third book in Apologia's acclaimed zoology series, *Exploring Creation with Zoology 3* will give students a tour through their own backyards, bring them on a safari and introduce them to the varied inhabitants of jungles, deserts, forests, farms and other ecosystems. Writing with Excellence

In this introductory course, students will begin the year learning how to write a correct paragraph. As the year progresses, they will learn to write several different styles of writing including narrative, research, persuasive, and descriptive. Students will use the writing process, which includes pre-writing, rough draft, editing, and final draft, to complete each major writing assignment.

- Fees: a \$30 fee covers supplements

Art 3rd – 6th

This course is designed to enhance the subjects of reading, writing, social studies, and the humanities through visual and tactile projects that are **FUN!** Projects may include but are not confined to: drawing, painting, sculpture, edible art, and book writing. A supply list will be provided.

Materials: a \$50 materials fee is required
