## Literature and Composition

### 7/8 Grammar/Literature

*Easy Grammar* texts use the prepositional approach to discovering the parts of speech and how they relate to one another. Spelling and vocabulary are drawn from Progeny Press's Literature Guides. These guides provide direction and structure to the study of popular and classic literature for young people. This class cannot count for high school credit.

**TUITION: \$450**

- Fees: a \$40 fee covers novel depreciation (\$10) and copy costs for literature supplements (\$30). Novels are owned by Cross Creek.

### American Literature

Teach the process of literary analysis that enables your student to interpret and evaluate what he or she reads in the light of Biblical truth. *American Literature* examines American Literature chronologically from the 1600s to the present and focuses on early American, romantic, realistic and modern genres.

### Elements of Literature

Strengthen your student's understanding of literature by focusing on advanced literary concepts such as sound and syntax, symbolism, irony, allusion and more. Each chapter introduces other aspects of literature; the Sound and Syntax chapter for example defines free verse, meter, feet, assonance, alliteration and rhyme before presenting literary examples of each. Several genres of literature are introduced (short fiction, biography, poetry) with examples from some of the greatest writers in history, including Shakespeare's *Romeo and Juliet*. Softcover, 464 pages.

### Chemistry
