

Cross Creek outlines plans for students to return in the Fall

- **In-person schooling is planned to return this fall for Cross Creek Christian School August 3rd.**
 - We will continue small class sizes.
 - We will continue to serve as a total home education umbrella. This is a great option for the families that are still uncomfortable sending their children to school. Families have the choice of purchasing lesson plans to help assist with total home education.
 - We will continue to offer 2 or 4 school days for Kindergarten – 6th grade.
 - We will continue to have small groups during lunch period and recess.
 - We plan to implement remote learning for those that would like to be taught by a teacher but not come to the campus.

- **Mask**
 - Mask for faculty and administration will be highly recommended but not required and will be optional for students.

- **What happens if someone test positive for the virus?**
 - The school will be shut done for three days.
 - All parents and students will be notified.
 - A student, faculty member, etc... that has had direct contact with a person who has tested positive for Covid-19 would need to not return to school and /or functions for a consecutive 14 day period or a 3 day period and have a negative test result before returning.
 - Anyone who test positive themselves will need to be cleared by a provider before returning to campus and the campus will shut down for a 3-5 day period; however, all those who made direct contact with said person must follow the above mentioned guidelines.

- **What are we doing to increase sanitation?**
 - There will be a Check point station before entering the building. Each individual will have their temperature taken, sign in, and use hand sanitizer before entering the building. Temperatures will need to be below 100 to enter.
 - There will be new hands free bathroom facets and soap dispensers.
 - There will be hands free hand sanitizer dispensers placed outside each restroom and in the kitchen.
 - Each classroom will have a sanitization station near their classroom door.
 - There will be a sanitization class taught to the students.
 - Teachers will sanitize classrooms at the end of each school day.
 - Lunch tables will be sanitized in between each group entering.
