English Classes

7th Grade Language Arts:

(Appropriate for 7th)

This class includes literature, composition, and grammar. We will continue teaching excellence in language arts through the Easy Grammar Work. Spelling and vocabulary are drawn from Progeny Press's Literature Study Guides. These guides provide direction and structure to the study of popular and classic literature for young people. Books to study include: *Davy Crockett, The Perilous Road, Sequoyah: The Cherokee Man Who Gave His People Writing, The Girls of Atomic City*

Write Shop Junior:

(Appropriate for 7th through 10th grades)

From the publisher (Write Shop): "Writing, Compositions, Paragraphs, Essays; do these words strike fear into your hearts? Well, you are not alone. Many people, young and old alike, break into a cold sweat when they face a blank piece of paper or computer screen. Likewise, students consider writing a chore. English and Literature of the Bible:

(Appropriate for 8th through 12th grades) (Can be used as a Literature credit OR an Elective credit)

This course will explore the Bible's literary techniques and its enormous variety of genres-everything from poetry to prophecy, as well as the historical periods that produced and are reflected in it. Our goal is to understand and appreciate more fully both the richness and the complexity of the biblical texts, as well as the importance of those texts to our culture, all while developing and honing literature analysis and language art skills.

Composition:

Composition is designed to develop students' abilities to think, organize, and express their ideas clearly and effectively in writing. Emphasis is placed on the various forms of expository writing such as description, narration, comparison, analysis, and argumentation. Appropriate materials including short stories and nonfiction works will be provided to allow students to practice gathering evidence to support their writing.

American Literature:

This class introduces students to American literature through a review of classic works. Students will focus on reading comprehension. Social Studies

Tennessee History:

(Appropriate for 7th and 8th grades)

Government / Economics:

(Appropriate for 10th through 12th grades)

The first semester of this class will explore the interworking of the American Government: House Bills, Constitutional analysis, Supreme Court cases and more. The second semester of the class will deal with Micro and Macro Economics. What are the laws of supply and demand and how do they affect our Economy? What is the GDP and how is it calculated? What does the SEC regulate? The students need to know that SEC does not just stand for the Southeastern Conference. The Notgrass Company *Exploring Government* curriculum is a one-semester (half-credit) high school course that covers the government of the United States from its beginning to the present with a special emphasis on the Biblical pattern for government and the U.S. Constitution. Students will learn about federal, state, and local government and become better equipped to understand our country's government as they learn about contemporary issues facing our nation today.

Mathematics

Math-7th Grade: (With Mr. Hall)

Focusing on algebraic reasoning and geometric concepts, Saxon Math Homeschool 8/7 teaches math with a spiral approach, which emphasizes incremental development of new material and continuous review of previously taught concepts. This Saxon 8/7 textbook reviews arithmetic calculation, measurements, geometry and other skills, and introduces pre-algebra, ratios, probability and statistics. Students will specifically learn about adding/subtracting/multiplying fractions, equivalent fractions, the metric system, repeating decimals, scientific notation, Pi, graphing inequalities, multiplying algebraic terms, the Pythagorean Theorem, the slope-intercept form of linear equations, and more.

Pre-Algebra:
